## Birds in parks, gardens and streets

Many birds have learnt to live with us. They use our parks and gardens and happily survive in our streets. You may find many of these birds in the Rifle Range in Wonthaggi, Seagrove Estate in Cowes, or even your own backyard.



### Wood Duck

A brown and grey duck that eats grass. Only seeks water if threatened.



### Starling

A black bird with white speckles. All black in summer with a yellow bill.



### Magpie

Familiar black and white bird. Males have a white back, females are grey.



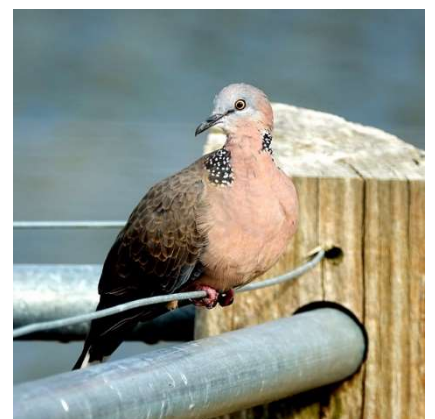
### Lapwing

Brown back, white front, yellow bill and face shield. Nests on open ground.



### Sparrow

Small bird often around shops, farms, picnic grounds, etc.



### Spotted Dove

Grey-brown and pink with a black band spotted white around the neck
