

Children's bird discovery walks for the Bass Coast area

Tree and bush birds

Our trees and patches of bush are favourite places for many birds to inhabit. They find food in the canopy, build nests in the branches or use the hollows. Places to see these birds might include the Guide Park in Wonthaggi, Oswin Roberts Reserve on Phillip Island and the Screw Creek Nature Walk at Inverloch.



Little Corella
Small cockatoo with a white crest, blue around the eye and a pale pink patch above the bill.



Eastern Rosella
A small, multi-coloured parrot.



Kookaburra
Familiar white, grey and brown bird with a pale blue wing patch.



Willie Wagtail
Small black and white bird – white belly and eyebrow. Busily chases insects near the ground.



Rainbow Lorikeet
Small, noisy, colourful parrot. Blue face and crown, yellow-orange chest, blue belly, green back.



Sulphur-crested Cockatoo
All white cockatoo with a yellow crest.
