

Whale Haiku Writing Competition Full Terms and Conditions

1. General

The Promoter is Myli - My Community Library Ltd, ABN 92 653 088 610 (Myli) of 2/65 Victoria Street, Warragul VIC 3820. Telephone (03) 5622 2849. Information on how to enter and prizes form part of the terms

of entry. Entry into the competition is deemed acceptance of these terms and conditions.

If there is any inconsistency between these Terms and Conditions and anything else that refers to this competition, these Terms and Conditions will prevail.

2. Who can enter

Entry is open to all Myli Bass Coast Library members except employees and immediate families of the Promoter and their associated companies and agencies. Bass Coast Library members means anyone with a Myli membership and a home library of one of the following Phillip Island, San Remo, Wonthaggi, Inverloch, Waterline, Coronet-Bay or Corinella.

Immediate family includes the following: spouse, ex-spouse, defacto spouse, child or step child (whether natural or by adoption), parent, step parent, grandparent, step grandparent, uncle, aunt, niece, nephew, brother, sister, step brother, step sister or first cousin.

Entrants may be any age to enter the competition. Entrants under the age of 18 years of age must complete their entry with a parent or guardian in order to be eligible to enter the competition.

The Promoter reserves the right to request winners to provide proof of identity, proof of residency at the nominated prize delivery address and/or proof of entry validity or proof of registration ownership in order to claim a prize. Proof of identification, residency and entry considered suitable for verification is at the discretion of the Promoter. In the event that a winner cannot provide suitable proof, the winner will forfeit the prize in whole and no substitute will be offered.

3. When to enter

Competitions commence on 26th June, 2023 and run when advertised through until July 7th, 2023. Entries must be received by the Promoter prior to the individual competition close dates and times.

The time of entry will be validated by staff in each time the entry is physically received by the Promoter.

The Promoter accepts no responsibility for any late, lost or misdirected entries due to technical disruptions, network congestion or for any other reason.

4. How to enter

Write a haiku of 3 lines, 5 syllables in the first line, then 7 syllables, ending with 5 syllables.

The haiku will have some relation to whales, whale migration or ocean themes Entrants may enter the competition by completing the competition entry form and physically submitting their entry to staff any Bass Coast library branch or email to sanremo@myli.org.au

Entrants are required to take full responsibility for the content of their entry and for ensuring that their entry complies with these Terms and Conditions. For the purposes of these content requirements, "entry content" includes any content (including text) that entrants submit in connection with their entry into the Promotion. Any entry that is made on behalf of an entrant by a third party will be invalid unless the entrant requires the assistance of a third party to enter on behalf of a minor or due to a disability.

The Promoter reserves the right to disqualify any entrant who tampers with the entry process, who submits an entry that is not in accordance with these Terms & Conditions of Entry or who has, in the opinion of Promoter, engaged in conduct in entering the Promotion which is fraudulent, misleading, deceptive or generally damaging to the goodwill or reputation of the Promotion and/or Promoter. This includes, but not limited, to entrants and households using multiple email addresses.

5. Number of Entries permitted

Multiple entries are permitted.

Multiple entries may be disqualified if an unreasonable number of submissions are received by a single member.

6. Draw and Notification of winner

The winner of each individual competition will be a valid entry submitted in accordance with these Terms and Conditions that is judged by two Myli representatives in July at Shop 1/92 Back Beach Road, San Remo VIC 3925. The Promoter's decision is final and the Promoter will not enter into correspondence regarding the competition result or any other decisions the Promoter makes in connection with the Promotion.

The winner will be notified by phone and email within 24 hours of the draw. The prize, a \$50 book voucher from Turn the Page Bookstore, will need to be collected in person from a Bass Coast library.

The prize will be awarded to the person named in the entry. However, in a dispute, will be awarded to the account holder of the entry mechanism used to submit their entry (i.e. Internet Service Provider account holder).

Should an entrant's contact details change during the promotional period, it is the entrant's responsibility to notify the Promoter. A request to access or modify any information provided in an entry should be directed to the Promoter.
