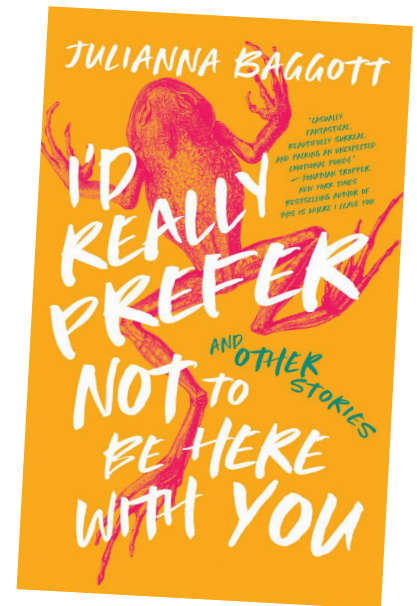


1. In "The Now of Now," why do you think she wouldn't stop time for her old friend?
